BOARD OF SUPERVISOR'S MINUTE BOOK

JANUARY 24, 2007

The Cherokee County Board of Supervisors met on Wednesday, January 25, 2007 with Dean Schmidt, Jeff Simonsen, Ron Wetherell, Terry Graybill and Mark Leeds. Mike Leckband of the *Chronicle Times* was present from the press.

1:00 p.m. Meeting opened with the Joe Draper, Jim Warrender and Dana Evans of the Veteran Affairs department. Supervisors suggested the possibility of moving the VA Director's office out of the Courthouse to another location. Options will be brought back to the Supervisors at a later date.

Medical Examiner budget will be increased because of the changes in mandated autopsies and transportation. Cherokee Regional Medical Center needs to have two EMT's trained to assist the Medical Examiner this fiscal year and two for the next fiscal year. Tax asking of \$13,620.00.

General Relief budget was reviewed; Sue Casey at the Cherokee DHS office administers this budget and does not request an increase. Tax asking of \$13,053.

Emergency Services budget has asked for a \$2,000.00 increase to \$10,000.00.

Graybill suggested that each of the County Libraries be increased by \$200.00.

Other discussion of budgets not reviewed will be reviewed at the next regular meeting on Tuesday, January 30, 2007.
