BOARD OF SUPERVISOR'S MINUTE BOOK  
CHEROKEE COUNTY, IOWA  
FEBRUARY 25, 2014

The Cherokee County Board of Supervisors met in regular session on Tuesday, February 25, 2014 with Mark Leeds, Jeff Simonsen, Rick Mongan, Dennis Bush, and Ginger Walker present. Dan Whitney, *Chronicle Times*, represented the press. Hedgie Brandt was also in attendance. Unless otherwise indicated, all votes were offered as follows: Ayes - Simonsen, Mongan, Bush, Walker, Leeds; Nays – none; Abstentions – none.

Motion by Bush, seconded by Simonsen to approve the agenda. Motion carried.

Motion by Mongan, seconded by Walker to approve the minutes of the previous meeting. Motion carried.

Motion by Simonsen, seconded by Walker to approve the claims for payment as presented. Motion carried. A complete listing is available for review in the County Auditor's office and online.

Jake Robertson requested an opportunity to purchase approximately 16.5 acres of land owned by Cherokee County east of Aurelia. After discussion with County Attorney Ryan Kolpin, the Board of Supervisors agreed to notify the public of their intent to sell a parcel of property through a sealed bid process.

Motion by Bush, seconded by Mongan to approve Resolution #2014-04 "Desire to Sell Real Property" and to set a public hearing on March 11, 2014 at 9:15 a.m. Roll call vote: Simonsen-aye, Mongan-aye, Bush-aye, Walker-aye, Leeds-aye. Motion carried and resolution adopted. Legal notice of the public hearing to sell property owned by Cherokee County will be published in all official newspapers with sealed bids being accepted until 9:00 a.m. on March 11, 2014.

Sandy O'Hearn, Environmental Health Specialist, introduced Justin Pritts as the new Environmental Health and Emergency Management Coordinator. The supervisors welcomed Pritts to his new position as an employee of the County.

There being no further business, Chairman Leeds adjourned the meeting at 10:30 a.m.
