BOARD OF SUPERVISOR'S MINUTE BOOK  
CHEROKEE COUNTY, IOWA  
OCTOBER 11, 2016

---

The Cherokee County Board of Supervisors met in regular session on Tuesday, October 11, 2016 with Dennis Bush, Rick Mongan, Gary Lundquist, Jim Peck, and Jeff Simonsen present. Ken Ross, *Chronicle Times*, represented the press. Justin Pritts and Barb Staver were also in attendance. Unless otherwise indicated, all votes were offered as follows: Ayes – Simonsen, Mongan, Lundquist, Peck, Bush; Nays – none; Abstentions – none.

Motion by Mongan, seconded by Lundquist to approve the agenda. Motion carried.

Motion by Peck, seconded by Mongan to approve the minutes of the previous meeting. Motion carried.

Motion by Mongan, seconded by Peck to approve the claims for payment as presented. Motion carried. A complete listing is available for review in the County Auditor's office and online.

Barb Staver, Sheriff's Office, presented a revenue report for consideration.

Motion by Lundquist, seconded by Peck to approve the Sheriff's \$48,821.04 September 30, 2016 Quarterly Revenue Report as presented with \$28,392.81 retained by the county. Motion carried.

Mark Murphy, County Recorder, presented a revenue report for consideration.

Motion by Mongan, seconded by Lundquist to approve the County Recorder's \$60,288.45 September 30, 2016 Quarterly Revenue Report with \$24,652.03 retained by the county. Motion carried.

Brandon Billings, County Engineer, presented utility permits and proposed agreements with the union and railroad.

Motion by Peck, seconded by Mongan to approve an underground utility permit for Iowa Lakes Electric Cooperative between Sections 10 & 15 of Marcus Township. Motion carried.

Motion by Lundquist, seconded by Peck to approve a Memorandum of Understanding with the International Union of Operating Engineers Local 234 agreeing to increase the base wage for the Sign Foreman position to \$21.92 for the remainder of the current contract. Motion carried.

A proposed maintenance agreement with the Chicago Central and Pacific Railroad for new crossings installed in Cherokee County was tabled for further research.

Motion by Mongan, seconded by Peck to approve ISG Field Services Invoice #1073 for submission to Dakota Access Pipeline for payment of inspection services provided from August 27, 2016 through September 24, 2016. Motion carried.

Jim Peck received a quote for resurfacing the Courthouse and Law Enforcement Center parking lots.

After discussion, the consensus was to pave the Law Enforcement Center parking lot at a later date instead of resurfacing with black top.

Motion by Lundquist, seconded by Peck to accept a \$14,500 quote from Blacktop Services to resurface the Courthouse parking lot and wait on the Law Enforcement Center parking lot. Motion carried.

The supervisors provided committee reports and reviewed meeting schedules.

There being no further business, Chairman Bush adjourned the meeting at 9:55 a.m.
