BOARD OF SUPERVISOR'S MINUTE BOOK
CHEROKEE COUNTY, IOWA
JANUARY 31, 2017

The Cherokee County Board of Supervisors met in regular session on Tuesday, January 31, 2017 with Dennis Bush, Rick Mongan, Gary Lundquist, Duane Mummert, and Jeff Simonsen present. Ken Ross, *Chronicle Times*, represented the press. Justin Pritts and Jerod Clyde were also in attendance. Unless otherwise indicated, all votes were offered as follows: Ayes – Simonsen, Mongan, Lundquist, Mummert, Bush; Nays – none; Abstentions – none.

Motion by Lundquist, seconded by Simonsen to approve the agenda. Motion carried.

Motion by Bush, seconded by Mummert to approve the minutes of the previous meeting. Motion carried.

Willis Allbaugh, Quimby Fire Department, requested financial support for the Quimby ambulance service and explained that the Quimby Fire and Rescue is providing coverage for the Washta area due to a very limited number of trained personnel on the Washta Fire Department. No action was taken.

Dick Sievers, Mid Sioux Opportunity, gave an informative review of services offered to area residents and reported that Cherokee County is getting a \$182 return for every dollar contributed. Mid Sioux's budget request for 2017/2018 is the same as it has been for the past several years and the supervisors will consider all requests during the budget process.

Lisa Bringle presented a summary of activities provided in the last quarter for General Assistance to Cherokee County residents.

The supervisors provided committee reports and reviewed meeting schedules.

There being no further business, Chairman Mongan adjourned the meeting at 10:00 a.m.
