BOARD OF SUPERVISOR'S MINUTE BOOK
CHEROKEE COUNTY, IOWA
SEPTEMBER 11, 2007

The Cherokee County Board of Supervisors met in regular session on Tuesday, September 11, 2007 with Dean Schmidt, Jeff Simonsen, Ron Wetherell, Terry Graybill and Mark Leeds. Ken Ross from the *Chronicle Times* and B.C. Dilocker were present.

MSP Leeds, Schmidt to approve the agenda and minutes of the previous meeting.

Lynde Lundquist, County Treasurer requested that the Supervisors approve the hiring of Mike Rupp in the drivers license department for 10 to 15 hours a week.

MSP Simonsen, Graybill to approve hiring Mike Rupp for part time in the Treasurer's office at \$10.00 per hour with start date of September 5, 2007.

Larry Clark, County Engineer is working with the County Attorney on vacating part of a road in Section 1 of Amherst Township due to relocating part of the county road.

MSP Graybill, Leeds to authorize Clark to proceed with splitting the 33 feet of right of way in Section 1 of Amherst Township and work with the adjoining land owner.

After much discussion regarding costs on 480th Street project, MSP Graybill, Schmidt to offer the appraised value plus relocation fees as determined by the County Engineer with a contract stating the vacating date for Sand property. Wetherell abstained from voting.

MSP Graybill, Simonsen to approve the Master Matrix scoring for Roving Winds, Inc. in Section 12 of Tilden Township and Mike and Gerald Radke in Section 12 of Diamond Township.

MSP Simonsen, Graybill to approve the claims as presented. A full list of claims can be seen in the Auditor's office.
