BOARD OF SUPERVISOR'S MINUTE BOOK
CHEROKEE COUNTY, IOWA
FEBRUARY 9, 2010

The Cherokee County Board of Supervisors met in regular session on Tuesday, February 9, 2010 with Larry Prunty, Dean Schmidt, Jeff Simonsen, Mark Leeds, and Terry Graybill present. There were no representatives from the press. Unless otherwise indicated, all votes were offered as follows: Ayes - Schmidt, Graybill, Prunty, Leeds, Simonsen; Nays – none; Abstentions – none.

Motion by Prunty, seconded by Leeds to approve the amended agenda and minutes of the previous meeting. Motion carried.

Chief Deputy Jeff Friedrichsen presented a wage authorization to fill a vacant deputy sheriff position and gave an update on projected costs of a sprinkler system for the law enforcement center.

Motion by Schmidt, seconded by Leeds to approve a wage authorization for Neal Galles as deputy sheriff beginning February 20, 2010. Motion carried.

Dave Shanahan, County Engineer, presented 3 bridge contracts for approval and discussed snow removal.

Motion by Schmidt, seconded by Leeds to approve a bridge contract with Christensen Bros. for project L-1-B-09. Motion carried.

Motion by Graybill, seconded by Prunty to approve a bridge contract with Christensen Bros. for project L-3-B-09. Motion carried.

Motion by Leeds, seconded by Prunty to approve a bridge contract with Christensen Bros. for project L-4-B-09. Motion carried.

Lisa Langlitz, Community Services Director, requested approval of the Magellan Health Contract for case management services.

Motion by Leeds, seconded by Graybill to approve a contract with Magellan Health Services. Motion carried.

Mark Buschkamp, CAEDC Director, updated the supervisors on the ongoing discussions in the legislature regarding possible closure of a mental health facility in Iowa and the possible effects on the Cherokee Mental Health Institute.

Motion by Graybill, seconded by Schmidt authorizing the chairman to sign a letter addressed to Congressman Steve King expressing support for the Highway 20 Corridor project. Motion carried.

Motion by Graybill, seconded by Prunty to approve the claims for payment as presented. Motion carried. A complete listing is available for review in the Auditor's office and online.

There being no further business, Chairman Simonsen adjourned the meeting at 11:10 a.m.
