The Cherokee County Board of Supervisors met in regular session on Tuesday, November 23, 2010 with Jeff Simonsen, Larry Prunty, Dean Schmidt, Terry Graybill, and Mark Leeds present. Mike Leckband, *Chronicle Times*, represented the press. Unless otherwise indicated, all votes were offered as follows: Ayes – Schmidt, Graybill, Prunty, Leeds, Simonsen; Nayes – none; Abstentions – none.

Motion by Leeds, seconded by Prunty to approve the agenda and minutes of the previous meeting. Motion carried.

Ryan Kolpin, County Attorney, was present to discuss several County owned land parcels.

Dave Shanahan, County Engineer, and Larry Walker, Roads Superintendent, reported on the River Road bridge. The recent weather has slightly delayed the project, with completion still about two weeks away. Other general business included FEMA reports and future projects.

In other business, the Board discussed the upcoming budget process. Motion by Graybill, seconded by Leeds to approve a 65 cent per hour increase for non-union employees. Motion carried.

Motion by Schmidt, seconded by Prunty to approve and sign the annual SIMPCO Local Hazard Mitigation Plan contract. Motion carried.

The 2011 annual Commercial Pesticide Applicators License renewal was presented. Motion by Prunty, seconded by Graybill to approve and sign naming Thomas Jenness as the applicator.

Motion by Graybill, seconded by Schmidt to approve the county claims as presented. Motion carried. A complete listing of the claims is available for review in the Auditor's office and online.
