Motion by Lundquist, seconded by Peck to approve the minutes of the previous meeting. Motion carried.

Motion by Peck, seconded by Mongan to approve the claims for payment as presented. Motion carried. A complete listing is available for review in the County Auditor's office and online.

Motion by Lundquist, seconded by Mongan to go into closed session per Iowa Code Chapter 21.5(1)(c) "To discuss strategy with counsel in matters that are presently in litigation or where litigation is imminent where its disclosure would be likely to prejudice or disadvantage the position of the governmental body in that litigation." Roll call vote: Peck-aye, Mongan-aye, Bush-aye, Lundquist-aye. Motion carried and session closed at 9:35 a.m. Regular session resumed at 10:11 a.m.

Motion by Mongan, seconded by Lundquist to allow the transfer of the TIF Agreement from Sand Seed to any potential buyer. Motion carried.
