BOARD OF SUPERVISOR'S MINUTE BOOK
CHEROKEE COUNTY, IOWA
APRIL 2, 2019

The Cherokee County Board of Supervisors met in regular session on Tuesday, April 2, 2019 with Dennis Bush, Rick Mongan, Gary Lundquist, Duane Mummert, and Wane Miller present. Steve Peterson, *Aurelia Star*, represented the press. William Gauthier, Mark Murphy, and Bill Anderson were also in attendance. Unless otherwise indicated, all votes were offered as follows: Ayes –Lundquist, Bush, Mummert, Miller, Mongan; Nays – none; Abstentions – none.

Motion by Mummert, seconded by Miller to approve an amended agenda to postpone the Weed Commissioner reports and to add a FEMA update from Justin Pritts, Emergency Management Director. Motion carried.

Motion by Bush, seconded by Lundquist to approve the minutes of the previous meeting. Motion carried.

Motion by Mummert, seconded by Miller to appoint Bill Anderson as Cherokee County representative on the SIMPCO Board of Directors. Motion carried.

The supervisors provided committee reports and reviewed meeting schedules.

Justin Pritts, Emergency Management Director, reported on the status of a FEMA claim for Cherokee County including the Cities of Cherokee and Quimby. Pritts stated that drone photos he took are what helped with getting a disaster declaration and pre-approval for \$4 million dollars of damages. Iowa Homeland Security is working with affected entities in the county to complete applications and secure funding to assist with the cleanup process. An application for mitigation funds has been sent to Iowa Homeland Security in hopes of making modifications to areas of the county and cities that are repeatedly damaged by flood waters.

There being no further business, Chairman Mongan adjourned the meeting at 9:38 a.m.

The supervisors toured the Iowa Food Group facility with Bill Anderson, CAEDC Director, and Steve Peterson, *Aurelia Star* Reporter.
